Thank you for your patience whilst we have been closed recently.

- ***AWS Plastics fire***

After the fire at AWS Plastics on 25th August we unfortunately had to close and we were not able to take any loads in until the 5th September due to toxic smoke blowing over the site and the risk of contaminating the grain. We apologise for any inconvenience this may have caused and thank you for your cooperation & patience during this time. On Friday 4th September it was confirmed that the grain had not been contaminated so we were able to start intaking the next morning.



- ***Harvest 2009***

Due to the fire we have had a slight setback with harvest intake. Currently 20,300t has been taken in and we have recommenced taking loads in.

- ***Camgrain visit***

Following a successful trip to Camgrain with some members & directors we are organising another visit for members to see how a site that large works & how Woldgrain will work in the future. - ***Project Valiant***

Clugston are currently waiting for prices to come back from sub contractors & suppliers and we anticipate all prices due by the end of September. We are still hopeful to start the building work in November. The design of Project Valiant is based on an 85,000t site which will include the following:

- Lorry turn around times in 30 minutes
- Discharge time in 7 minutes
- Intake capacity 900t/hr
- Dryer capacity 2x 100t/hr
- Conveyor & elevator speeds 150t/hr
- 2 weighbridges
